Dear Deputy Prime Minister

I write regarding the Australian Government's Black Spot Program.

I also refer to an article in the Brisbane Times of 21 August 2020 named *'Queensland's top 10 most dangerous intersections.'*

The ninth most dangerous intersection is listed as the corner of Cavendish Road and Kitchener Street/Holdsworth Street in Coorparoo, in my electorate of Griffith.

Locals in my community are sick and tired of being stuck in congestion on the Southside, meaning they are spending more time in their cars and less time at home.

At the last election, I committed \$2.24 billion to build Cross River Rail and more than \$100 million to fix the Coorparoo Level Crossing, to bust traffic congestion in my community.

To date, the Morrison Government hasn't spent one dollar on fixing traffic congestion on the Southside.

As the Federal Government's Black Spot Program is designed to target locations where crashes occur, I ask what the Morrison Government is doing to ease traffic congestion on Brisbane's Southside and address the ninth most dangerous intersection in Queensland.
